- Additional Exercises incl. Advices on Sitting, Sleeping, Stretching, Training, Posture etc.

Practical Part: (Spread over 2 Days)

- Review of the complete Dorn-Therapy in Segments with Demonstration and Hands-on treatment of the students sharing roles. (Following original and new advanced and special techniques developed by different Dorn Method Teachers and based on applied Anatomy and Physiology)
- The Dorn Therapy Part applied as Self Help Method as Founder Dieter Dorn and International Dorn Method Instructor Thomas Zudrell is proposing the Method, i.e. a neutral and mostly passive application of the techniques for Demonstration purpose and special cases.
- Complete Treatment under supervision, ('real' patient simulation)
- Review of the critical points: Cervical Spine, Sacrum and others

- The Breuss Massage (Review and Variations) (optional, time permitting)
